

COVID 19 Golf Event Operating Procedures

- If any player is showing signs of illness, they are asked to stay at home.
 Refunds will be at the discretion of the Event Coordinator.
- Players are asked to arrive at the course no more than 45 prior to their tee time.
- Physical distancing of 6' should be practiced during warm up and during announcements.
- In an effort to maintain social distancing, wider than normal hitting areas have been set up on the driving range.
- Each team should designate one person to be in charge of keeping score.
- Each golf car is equipped with a divider if the players choose to use it.
- Each golf car is sanitized before each round.
- Restroom facilities will be open but social distancing will be strictly enforced.
- All players should refrain from celebrating with their fellow competitors within a 6' of each other. "Putter Head" high fives are encouraged!
- All flagsticks shall remain in the hole and should not be removed during the course of play.
- Each player will receive their starting hole assignments the day before the event. In an effort to minimize traffic in the clubhouse, please feel free to go directly to your golf car.
- Mask/facial covering should be worn in accordance with state government guidelines when a 6-foot distance cannot be met.
- Hand sanitizer will be available at the starting and the scoring areas.
- Bunker rakes have been removed from the course. Please use your foot to smooth the disturbed area after play. All bunkers will be played as lift, clean and place.
- No scoreboards will be used for events to eliminate gatherings.
