#### **Scripture Memory**

#### **Sermon Summary**

What sets the church apart from every other community? According to John 13:34-35, the love of Christ makes Christian community unique through the cross. The love of Christ creates Christian community and moves us to love one another as Christ loved us. As we sacrificially love one another in this way, the love of Christ enables us to display the gospel to the world around us.

#### **Discussion Guide**

- How does it change you to know that Christ loves you?
- How have you experienced the love of Christ in Christian community and in our church?
- Where do you struggle to live out the new commandment?
- What threatens to divide the church and hinder us from displaying the gospel?
- Where is God leading you to live out the new commandment this week?

#### **Prayer Guide**

- As a disciple, praise God that He has displays His love for us through the cross of Christ.
- For your family, pray that we would love one another sacrificially as Christ loved us.
- For our church, pray that we would be united by the gospel and not our preferences.
- For our city, pray that our city would see God’s love through how we love one another.
- For our world, pray that they would see the church united by the gospel and nothing else.
