Luke 19:1-10

Scripture Memory

For the Son of Man came to seek and to save the lost. Luke 19:10 (ESV)

Sermon Summary

Luke 19:1-10 shows us that Jesus came to save the lost and transform lives. In the opening of this passage we see that amidst all that Zacchaeus had, something was still missing in his life, leading him to seek out Jesus. In meeting Jesus, Zacchaeus was transformed from the inside out. He was no longer someone who profited off of people for his own gain but was now a follower of Jesus Christ who generously blessed people for their good. Ultimately, we see that although Zacchaeus may have been seeking Jesus (v. 3), it was actually Jesus who came to seek and save Zacchaeus (v.10).

Discussion Guide

- In what ways are people seeking and searching for significance today?
- How is a gospel transformed life a powerful argument for the gospel itself?
- Like Zacchaeus, what was your life like before and how has the gospel transformed it?
- Where is the grace of God leading you to be more gracious and generous this week?

Prayer Guide

- As a disciple, praise God that Jesus came to seek and save you (Lk 19:10).
- For your family, pray the grace of God would make you more gracious to one another.
- For our church, pray that we would be a transformed people who display the gospel.
- For our city, pray that those searching for significance would be found by Christ.
- For our world, pray for a gospel harvest in a world that is searching for significance.
