Sermon Summary

If our church stopped celebrating the Lord’s Supper, what difference would it make? Luke 22:7-23 shows us that the Lord’s Supper is a remembrance but it is also a celebration of who Jesus is, what He has accomplished for us, and the difference that should make in our everyday lives. First, the Lord’s Supper shows us how Jesus greatly desires to be in relationship with us. Second, the Lord’s Supper shows that we are to live freely and gratefully because we have been forgiven with the finished work of Christ. Finally, the Lord’s Supper shows us that the Lord’s Table transforms our dining table as we pursue gospel hospitality.

- How is the Lord’s Supper both an act of remembrance and celebration?
- How does the Lord’s Supper both comfort and convict you as a disciple?
- How is the Lord’s Table leading you to change the way you see your dining table this week?
