Talk About the Scripture at Home

Last week we heard about Joseph's brothers selling Joseph to traders to be a slave. At one point Joseph ended up in prison, even though he did nothing wrong. Joseph trusted God to help him and he made friends with some other prisoners. The prisoners told Joseph about dreams that they had and God helped Joseph interpret the dreams. A few days later the dreams, and Joseph's interpretation, came true! One of the prisoners became free and began serving Pharaoh. Later on, Pharaoh had two strange dreams and no one could interpret them! The servant remembered Joseph and told Pharaoh about him. Pharaoh called Joseph and Joseph interpreted the dreams, letting Pharaoh know that there would be seven years where there would be a lot of food in the land, but after that there would be no food for seven years because there would be no rain. Pharaoh saw that Joseph was very wise and made him a ruler in Egypt.

For the first seven years, Joseph stored up lots of food! He continued to trust God to help him and he stored up so much food that there was none left to store! When the seven years of no food came, he had plenty to give out. There were people in other countries who didn't have food to eat. Joseph's father sent his brothers to Egypt to buy some food. They did not recognize Joseph, but Joseph recognized them. He gave his brothers food and sent them home. Can you imagine what Joseph was feeling?! Later they came back for more food and Joseph shared with them who he was. His brothers were afraid, but Joseph trusted God and told them not to be afraid. He said to them that what they meant for evil, God meant for good!! His brothers rushed home, told their father, and they all moved to Egypt!
